PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE VILLAGE SIGN ORDINANCE November 10, 2011

(Note: the purpose of this proposal is to regulate placement of signs in the zoned business district by people who do not own or manage a business in the business district. This could reduce sign clutter and shield local businesses from out of town competition.)

Subd 10 Sign Permits

(number) Individuals/ businesses not operating a business in the zoned Business District but operating a business within 2 miles of the Business District must file an application for a sign with the Zoning Administrator. The two mile radius is based from the intersection of Highway 35 and Spring Street.

Individuals/ businesses operating outside the two mile area are not allowed to erect signs in the Village.

Those businesses within the Village limit but outside the Business District which already have approved signage will not be eligible for additional signs under this amendment.

Proposed signs must follow the requirements for double-faced or single faced freestanding advertising or identifying signs found in Subd 8 c. The requester must include a sketch of the sign including dimensions. The application must also include a letter from the property owner of the proposed sign site giving permission for the sign.

If the application is approved, and the fee paid, the sign can be in place only on days the store is open and for a period of one year.

The fee will be determined by the Village Board.

Other pertinent elements of this Ordinance also apply.
